

# EQUIPMENT LIST (warm-weather cabin camping)

Pack it all in a waterproof duffel bag or backpack. No suitcases, please!

- Sleeping equipment
- \_\_\_\_\_ Sleeping bag
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Stuff sack for sleeping bag or rope to tie sleeping bag together
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Small pillow
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Pajamas / t-shirt & shorts to sleep in
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Special blanket or stuffed animal
- Changes of clothing: One for each day plus one extra
- \_\_\_\_\_ Shirts
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Long pants and/or Shorts (may want one pair of long pants for cool nights)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Underwear
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Socks
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Shoes (bring an extra pair--bring a crummy pair for creek-walking!)  
***No sandals, jellies or open-toed shoes!!!***
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Dirty clothes bag (an extra grocery bag will do)
- Weather-related clothing:
- \_\_\_\_\_ Rain poncho or rain coat (we never know if it might rain!)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Light Jacket or sweatshirt (the nights will be cooler)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Hat (to wear and to hold swaps – full hat, no visors)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Sunglasses (optional)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Sunscreen
- Toiletries
- \_\_\_\_\_ Toothbrush and toothpaste – in small ziploc bag
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Washcloth -- in a small ziploc bag
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Soap -- in container or ziploc bag (scent-free! to avoid attracting insects)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Face towel
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Personal items (deodorant, sanitary supplies, face wash, etc. as needed)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Brush/comb and rubber bands for long hair
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Tissues, ChapStick, bug repellent (stick please, no sprays or lotion)
- For Leaders/Adults
- \_\_\_\_\_ Comfortable camping chair
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Chocolate, caffeine, and your painkiller of choice

- \_\_\_\_\_ **Canteen or water bottle**
- \_\_\_\_\_ **Whistle**
- \_\_\_\_\_ If cooking out: Mess kit, utensils, and dunk bag (or plate, plastic cup, utensils)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Bandanna
- \_\_\_\_\_ Backpack or hip pack to carry your things around in during the day or on hikes
- \_\_\_\_\_ SWAPs and a hat or ribbon or ziploc bag to carry them in
- \_\_\_\_\_ Flashlight with extra batteries
- \_\_\_\_\_ Sit upon or camp chair
- \_\_\_\_\_ Optional: Camera and film, autograph book, card games or board games to share
- \_\_\_\_\_ Pocket knife -- *only if directed by troop leader*
- \_\_\_\_\_ Sack lunch or money for Friday night dinner

**No food, gum, or candy! No aerosol cans or glass! No jewelry!**  
**Avoid scented items--they attract biting insects!**

**Suggestions:** Get some 2-gallon zip-lock bags. Bag #1 for toiletries; one for each set of clothing in separate bags; one for sleeping clothes; one for stuffed animal, hat, flashlight, extra batteries; one for eating equipment; and one for miscellaneous items. This keeps things waterproof and organized. If you can't find this size baggie, plastic grocery bags will do.

# TROOP EQUIPMENT LIST

## General troop items:

- \_\_\_\_\_ Health forms and permission slips and emergency packets for each driver
- \_\_\_\_\_ Troop First Aid Kit
- \_\_\_\_\_ Paper Towels
- \_\_\_\_\_ Bleach
- \_\_\_\_\_ Garbage bags
- \_\_\_\_\_ Materials for Kaper Charts
- \_\_\_\_\_ Materials for troop activities (reference books, craft materials, etc.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ S'mores and roasting sticks
- \_\_\_\_\_ Any snacks your girls might need
- \_\_\_\_\_ Campfire equipment:
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Matches and fire starters
  - \_\_\_\_\_ A few extra hair ties
- \_\_\_\_\_ \* Lantern – most campsites have lights, but these are sometimes nice to have
- \_\_\_\_\_ Tissues

## Cooking Equipment (if your troop is doing any cooking, here are some of the items you may need to bring):

- \_\_\_\_\_ Food (or else it'll be a very long weekend)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Ice chest and ice
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Pitchers/Coolers for drinks
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Utensils/plates – or have girls bring mess kits
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Matches and fire starters
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Charcoal and/or Propane stove and fuel and extra fuel
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Pots, Skillets, Dutch Ovens, Griddles as needed
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Pot holders
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Sharp knives and cutting board
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Serving spoons/forks
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Potato peelers
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Cheese grater
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Spatulas
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Bowls (esp. serving bowls)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Aluminum foil and zip-lock bags (always useful)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Marshmallow toasters
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Tongs (useful for many things)
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Can opener
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Salt, pepper, and other flavorings
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Cooking oil
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Hand washing assembly and soap
  - \_\_\_\_\_ Dishwashing assembly (buckets or dishpans, soap, bleach, scrubbies, sponges, dish towels)
- \_\_\_\_\_ \* If you are tenting: Tents, rain flies, ground cloths, foam pads, mallets, stakes, poles., broom to sweep tent out  
Make sure to check for all the stakes, poles, and rain flies before you leave!
- \_\_\_\_\_ Maps/GPS/compass/directions
